Criteria for the CIIPA Pioneer Award

General Criteria:

- Minimum 25 years post qualification
- CIIPA member in good standing
- Other accounting body in good standing

Key Considerations:

- Significant career achievements
- Demonstrate commitment in community or volunteer services
- Contributing to the development of young professional accountants
- Significant commitment and contribution to the accounting profession
- Instrumental in the development of CIIPA into the organization that it is today

General Rules:

- Each nominator may submit only one nominee for consideration
- An individual may only win the award once
- The award is given at the discretion of the selection committee
- Individuals may be re-nominated in future years, or the selection committee may contact prior year nominees for future year's considerations, providing individuals still meet award criteria
